

Homeroom Parent Responsibilities

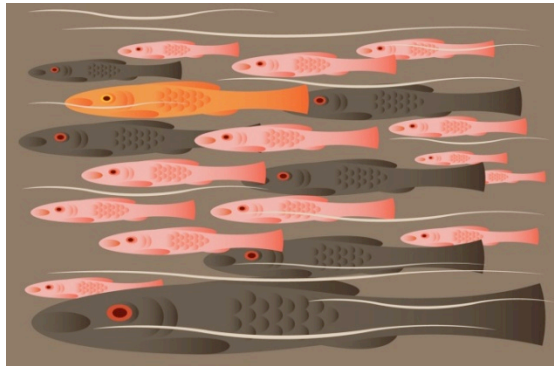
1. Attend Homeroom Parent's meeting September 18th 10:00AM.
2. Meet with teacher and co-parent early in the school year to clearly establish your role(s) in the classroom. Discuss parties, class trips, food allergies &/or health/safety, special events.
3. Meet with classroom parents. Plan an informal meeting early in the year to discuss plans for the class such as parties, teacher gifts and volunteer sign-ups.
4. Coordinate teacher gifts for December and June. These decisions are individual to each class. The parent get together is a great time to brainstorm.
5. Communicate with classroom parents throughout the year. Try your best to include as many parents in volunteer opportunities as possible. Welcome new families to the class; inform the New Parent Partners Committee Chairperson(s) on arrival of new students.
6. Communicate need for volunteers in the classroom and school wide. Help with other committees/events as you are able. News is often sent as email, forwarding email will be involved.
7. Organize photographers or be a photographer at class functions for the Memory Book. You may be able to designate a class photographer.
8. Collate communication packet once every four weeks for your grade level and deliver to teacher's mailboxes. The Communication Packet Chairperson will provide a schedule. Packets are assembled Wednesday mornings at 9AM. Younger children and friends are welcome to help.
9. Coordinate Art & Garden (spring fundraiser) project with teacher and parents. An Art & Garden liaison will be available if needed.
